3. HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION SUMMARY

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN – CAUTION – Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Avoid breathing spray mist. Remove contaminated clothing and wash thoroughly before reuse.

This product is a colorless, oily liquid with no noticeable odor. Primary routes of entry are Inhalation, eye contact and skin contact.

Warning Statement:

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Contains petroleum distillates, vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.

4. FIRST AID MEASURES

If swallowed: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Do not give any liquid to person. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

If on skin or clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

FOR A MEDICAL EMERGENCY INVOLVING THIS PRODUCT Have the product label or container with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

5. FIRE FIGHTING MEASURES

FLASH POINT (°F/Test Method): 335°F/168.4°C (TCC)

FLAMMABLE LIMITS (LEL & UEL): Not established

EXTINGUISHING MEDIA: May be combustible at high temperature, use medium appropriate to surrounding fire. Dry chemical, carbon dioxide, foam, water spray or fog.

HAZARDOUS COMBUSTION PRODUCTS: May include but are not limited to oxides of carbon, and/or other asphyxiants.

6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

STEPS TO BE TAKEN IF MATERIAL IS RELEASED OR SPILLED:

Contain the spill (wear the proper PPE) by absorbing spilled liquid with clay or other absorbent material; scoop or sweep up material and place in container. Decontaminate area by washing with soapy water solution and absorbing the water with absorbent material. Check local, state and federal regulations for proper disposal.

CAUTION: Keep spills and cleaning runoff out of municipal sewers and open bodies of water.

7. HANDLING AND STORAGE

HANDLING: Avoid inhalation and skin contact when handling oil. Wash hands after handling, and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet. Remove clothing immediately if pesticide gets inside. Then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing. Remove PPE immediately after handling this product. Wash the outside of gloves before removing. As soon as possible, wash thoroughly and change into clean clothing. See Section 8 for PPE. Keep away from children.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry area, away from heat and open flame. Keep in a secure area away from children, feed and foodstuffs, other pesticides, fertilizer, and seed. Do not contaminate water supplies by handling and storage of product. Drift or runoff may adversely affect non-target plants.
