**FIRST AID**

**GENERAL USE DIRECTIONS**

FIRST CHOICE Neutralizer is a spreader sticker with a combined buffering agent for increasing the efficiency of various agricultural chemical applications by reducing the pH for highly alkaline waters.

**SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING.** FIRST CHOICE NEUTRALIZER SHOULD BE ADDED AS THE FIRST INGREDIENT INTO THE SPRAY TANK. CARE SHOULD BE TAKEN TO PROVIDE AGITATION DURING THE ADDITION TO INSURE THOROUGH MIXING.

**Insecticides On Field Crops:** 1 to 4 pints per 100 gallons of water.

**Herbicides On Field Crops:** 2 to 6 pints per 100 gallons of water.

**Defoliants On Field Crops:** 2 to 6 pints per 100 gallons of water.

**Foliage Applied Nutrients:** 1 to 6 pints per 100 gallons of water to provide a mildly acidic environment on the plant surfaces.

The above minimum and maximum amounts of this material are suggested and will depend upon the total alkalinity of the water being used.

Some pesticides may require higher rates for optimum performance. Refer to the pesticide label for the manufacturer's recommended surfactant. Do not add this product at a rate which exceeds 5% of the finished spray volume.
