GENERAL USE DIRECTIONS

First Choice 0-12-0 is a combination spreader-activator and nutrient buffer with non-foaming properties. This adjuvant blend gives both wetting and pH adjustment, while acting as an antifoam agent. FIRST CHOICE 0-12-0 S.A.B. is an acid-based product that will acidify and buffer alkaline spray solutions and reduce degradation of certain pesticides, such as organophosphates and caramates. When used with foliar applied pesticides, FIRST CHOICE 0-12-0 S.A.B. increases activity by providing quick wetting for more uniform coverage. A phosphate based product, FIRST CHOICE 0-12-0 S.A.B. increases activity by providing quick wetting for more uniform coverage. A phosphate based product, FIRST CHOICE 0-12-0 S.A.B. also improves plant uptake of foliar micronutrients. It is compatible with most commonly used miticides, insecticides, herbicides and defoliants.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

SHAKE BEFORE USING

For use with acaricides, insecticides, herbicides, fungicides, defoliants. This product may be used in dilute or concentrate sprays.

Compatibility: FIRST CHOICE 0-12-0 S.A.B. is compatible with most pesticides and fertilizers. However if the desired combination has not been used previously, a compatibility test is suggested. Tank mixes with copper-based products can be phytotoxic due to the increased availability of copper.

For use as a Buffer Solution:

When added to water with a pH of 8:
1 Quart (1 liter) in 100 gallons of water will lower pH to 3
½ Quart (1/2 liter) in 100 gallons of water will lower pH to 4.

For use as a Foliar Spray and Spray Adjuvant:

Use 1 to 2 quarts per acre.

Proper rate to be used will vary with water pH, hardness, method of application, other products in tank, etc. Unless otherwise stated, always add FIRST CHOICE 0-12-0 S.A.B. prior to addition of pesticide.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Follow all recommended governmental procedures for disposal of pesticides sprays solution.

Triple rinse container, empty residue into spray tank. Contact county agricultural commissioner for container disposal information.
