FIRST CHOICE 80S SPREADER STICKER is a clear liquid spray adjuvant containing high quality nonionic surfactants and a superior resin based sticker. It is specifically formulated to provide maximum wetting, spreading, deposition and adherence of agricultural sprays to improve the coverage and retention of insecticides, miticides and fungicides. FIRST CHOICE 80S SPREADER STICKER is compatible with a wide range of materials and is not negatively affected by hard water. FIRST CHOICE 80S SPREADER STICKER is a superior sticker-extender agent developed to protect spray residue from erosion by rain, irrigation or other forms of weathering. FIRST CHOICE 80S SPREADER STICKER is a water dispersible, resinous surfactant which is non-water soluble. Thus, it resists re-wetting and removal by rain.

The very high surface tension reducing properties of FIRST CHOICE 80S SPREADER STICKER, plus its superior non-rewettable resin based sticker allow for maximum coverage and distribution of sprays, and then tenacious adherence to plant surfaces.

### USE INSTRUCTIONS

FIRST CHOICE 80S SPREADER STICKER may be used on all field, forage, fruit, nut and vegetable crops destined for fresh market or processing. FIRST CHOICE 80S SPREADER STICKER may be used with most insecticides, miticides and fungicides.

Do not use with Omite® on fruits or nuts. Do not use with sprays containing Gibberellic Acid.

### FIRST CHOICE 80S SPREADER STICKER

Use Rates	Ounces per 100 Gallons
High Volume Sprayers (Over 200 gal/acre)	4-16 oz.
Concentrate Sprayers (50-200 gal/acre) (10-50 gal/acre)	4-16 oz. 6-32 oz.
Aircraft Spraying (5-20 gal/acre)	16-32 oz.

Optimum rates will vary depending on field and application conditions. Generally, lower rates are used for easy to wet plants or when post-application weather conditions appear favorable. Use higher rates for hard to wet plants or when post-application rainfall is likely. Spray at least 1 hour prior to anticipated rain. This amount of time is usually required for the resin sticker to set.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**DO NOT CONTAMINATE WATER, FOOD OR FEED BY STORAGE OR DISPOSAL.**

**STORAGE:** Do not store near any source of heat or flame. Store only in original container.

**DISPOSAL:** Triple rinse all containers, puncture and dispose of in a landfill approved for pesticides, or by incinerating if permitted by State and local authorities. Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site, or at an approved waste disposal facility.

**IN CASE OF SPILLS:** Stay upwind and away from spill unless wearing appropriate protective equipment. Keep out of drains, sewers, or waterways. Flush spilled material into suitable retaining area or containers with large quantities of water. Small amounts of spilled material may be absorbed into an appropriate absorbent.
