### GENERAL INFORMATION

FIRST CHOICE DriftGon is an effective, easy-to-use adjuvant for deposition improvement and drift retardation in spraying operations. FIRST CHOICE DriftGon is compatible with most water soluble and wettable powder pesticides, desiccants and cotton defoliant when applied by aerial application or standard ground spray equipment.

May also be used with Glyphosate herbicides such as RoundUp Pro™, Roundup Pro Dry™, Aquamaster™ and Rodeo™.

When used as directed, First Choice DriftGon is exempt from tolerance requirements under Title 40, Code of Federal Regulations 180.1001 (d).

### USE PRECAUTIONS

The degree of drift hazard varies with the type of pesticide, application conditions, and vegetation near the sprayed area. Consult your local agricultural advisor. Remember, pesticide drift is no accident. Common sense and sound application technology must be followed when spraying pesticides. FIRST CHOICE DriftGon will retard, but not totally eliminate drift.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

- STEP 1. Select correct dosage from the dosage chart .
- STEP 2. Fill mix tank with water and pesticide. Start to agitate.
- STEP 3. Add FIRST CHOICE DriftGon.
- STEP 4. If additional surfactant or other spray adjuvants are used, they may be added after FIRST CHOICE DriftGon.
- STEP 5. Continue to agitate mix tank for at least 2 minutes before spraying.
- STEP 6. Follow all cleanup precautions on label of pesticide used. Follow governmental procedures for disposal of pesticide spray solution.

### DOSAGE CHART

Spray Pressure	Nozzle Orientation	*Suggested Usage Rates
Aerial Applied (below 45 psi)	Straight back 45" angle back	2-4 quarts 3-5 quarts
Ground - Low (below 30 psi)	Flat Fan, Flood Off-Center	1-3quarts 2-3 quarts
Medium (below 30-50 psi)	Flat Fan, Flood Off-Center Spray guns	2-3 quarts 3-4 quarts 3-5 quarts
High (50 – 150 psi)	Spray guns**	3-10 quarts

\*per 100 gallons of spray solution.

\*\*For home and garden sprayers, use approximately ¼ cup of FIRST CHOICE DriftGon per 5 gallons of spray solution.

### HANDLING AND STORAGE

Keep from freezing. For optimum storage stability, store at temperatures between 40°F (5° C) and 90° F (32° C). Spills become very slippery when mixed with water. Avoid contact with eyes and skin. Do not store near oxidizing agents

### CONTAINER DISPOSAL

Triple rinse. Then offer container for recycling or reconditioning or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill. If incineration is allowed, stay out of smoke.
