GENERAL INFORMATION

Western Farm Service 16-16-16 SP is a quality granular fertilizer developed for agricultural growers, landscapers and turf professionals. This formulation includes Iron and Zinc, two micronutrients often deficient in our alkaline soil conditions. Western Farm Service 16-16-16 SP is formulated using Sulfate of Potash, which reduces the amount of chloride and improves plant safety. This formulation is excellent for applications that require a uniform ratio of Nitrogen, Phosphorous and Potassium.

APPLICATION PRECAUTIONS

The application rates listed are only guidelines used in developing a fertilizer program. The rates may not apply to your local growing conditions. It is the grower's responsibility to determine the appropriate application rates. Trial this product before use under your local growing conditions, application methods and desired rates. Adjust irrigation volume and frequency to maintain appropriate soluble salt levels. Iron and other plant nutrients can cause staining of cement. Avoid mounding of fertilizer against base of plants. Store in a clean, cool and dry location.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Consult your crop advisor for specific nutrient requirements based on soil and tissue testing.

PREPLANT (Garden, Landscape and Turf): Broadcast 4 to 10 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft., cultivate into top 4" -6 "of soil.

TURFGRASS (Established): Uniformly apply 5 to 9 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft.

TURFGRASS (Overseeding): Uniformly apply 5 to 9 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft.

LANDSCAPE BEDS: Uniformly apply to surface of soil 7.5 to 10 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft.

SHRUBS AND EVERGREENS: Sprinkle ¼ cup evenly around the drip-line and work into the top 1" of soil.

TREE CROPS (Citrus and Avocado):

New Plantings: 1 tablespoon per tree 3 times per year. Uniformly apply around tree canopy drip-line.

Young Trees (1 to 2 years): 2 to 8 oz. per tree 3 times per year. Uniformly apply around tree canopy drip-line.

2 to 7 Year Old Trees: ½ to 2 lbs. per tree 3 times per year. Uniformly apply around tree canopy drip-line.

Mature Trees: 4 to 6 lbs. per tree 3 times per year. Uniformly apply around tree canopy drip-line.
