### DRIP IRRIGATION:

SP IRON is recommended for all field, row, vegetable, fruit, tree, vine, ornamental and turf crops.

SP ZINC may be used in drip irrigation systems.

#### ALL CROPS:

Micronutrient Maintenance ..... \*1-3 qts./acre  
Deficiency, Non-Visible ..... 2-6 qts./acre  
Deficiency, Visible ..... 1-3 gal/acre

\*The lower rates are for field, row and vegetable crops. The higher rates are for fruit, tree, vine, ornamental and turf crops. When rates of over 2 quarts are called for, split or multiple applications of 2 quarts or less each are preferred. Applications should be separated by a minimum of 10-14 days.

#### LIQUID FERTILIZER APPLICATIONS:

This product may be applied with all nitrogen solutions. Thoroughly mix this product with the nitrogen solution before applying. Avoid application with phosphate fertilizers, unless in acid form.
