DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Apply from 2 to 4 qts. of First Choice® K-LUX by ground in a minimum of 20 gallons of water per acre.

Aerial application - Apply from 2 to 4 qts. of First Choice® K-LUX per acre along with 1 to 5 gallons of water per acre.

For best results, make two or three applications of First Choice® K-LUX throughout the growing season.

First Choice K-LUX is compatible with most crop protection chemicals.
