GENERAL INFORMATION

FIRST CHOICE MICRONITE CITRUS SPECIAL is specially formulated as a micronutrient spray for the correction and prevention of micronutrient deficiencies in citrus. FIRST CHOICE MICRONITE CITRUS SPECIAL contains zinc, iron, manganese and magnesium in a form which is readily available when applied to the foliage of growing plants. FIRST CHOICE MICRONITE CITRUS SPECIAL should be applied only to citrus.

FIRST CHOICE MICRONITE CITRUS SPECIAL is compatible with most commonly used pesticides. Prior to use, always make a jar test of the products to be used before making a tank mix to check for physical compatibility. Always refer to the pesticide label for compatibility or tank mix standards.

When tank mixing FIRST CHOICE MICRONITE CITRUS SPECIAL with fixed copper or Bordeaux sprays, maintain the pH of the finished spray solution at or above 6.0.

Caution should be exercised when including a buffer or acidifier adjuvant as this product will lower spray solution pH.

APPLICATION INFORMATION

Always include a high quality non-ionic surfactant, such as FIRST CHOICE NO FOAM A, to improve spray coverage and efficacy.

Avoid making applications to crops growing under stress or during periods of high temperature and low humidity.

Avoid concentrate spray tank combination with phosphorous fertilizers.

For best results, make application by ground during the early morning or evening hours. Best responses occur when adequate soil moisture is available and actively growing leaf tissue is present.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Apply FIRST CHOICE MICRONITE CITRUS SPECIAL at rates of 2-4 quarts per acre per application, as needed, during periods of rapid growth. As micronutrient deficiencies persist into summer months, repeat with a 1-2 quart per acre application. For maintenance sprays, use lower rates.

As thorough coverage is essential for adequate crop response, FIRST CHOICE MICRONITE CITRUS SPECIAL should be applied by ground only, and in a minimum of 20 gallons of water per acre.

Always apply the principles of Best Management Practices when using this and other agricultural products. Soil and leaf tissue analyses, visual observations should be made to confirm agronomic need for this product.
