**GENERAL INFORMATION**

**FIRST CHOICE HAYBOOST** is a premium balanced nutritional blend designed to supply essential plant food nutrients to alfalfa hay, and other forage crops, between cuttings. Apply **FIRST CHOICE HAYBOOST** to maximize yield and quality.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

**FIRST CHOICE HAYBOOST** should be applied through irrigation and may be applied with additional nitrogen. **FIRST CHOICE HAYBOOST** may also be applied as a broadcast ground application where irrigation is not possible. Consult with your Western Farm Service Crop Advisor for proper recommendations.

**APPLICATION RATES**

Apply **FIRST CHOICE HAYBOOST**, after harvest, at the rate of 2 to 4 gallons per acre, through first or second sprinkler irrigations. Similar applications should be made following harvest of sequential cuttings.

In place of applications through sprinkler irrigation, **FIRST CHOICE HAYBOOST** may be applied as a ground application at 2 to 4 gallons per acre in at least 20 gallons of spray solution.
