GENERAL INFORMATION

FIRST CHOICE Boron Liquid 10% is a mid-range pH source of nitrogen and boron which can be tank mixed with common liquid fertilizers. **FIRST CHOICE Boron Liquid 10%** can be applied as a starter fertilizer, as side-dress, as a foliar, or through irrigation equipment. Consult with your Western Farm Service Crop Advisor for proper recommendations. **FIRST CHOICE Boron Liquid 10%** can be used on field, row, tree or vine crops.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

SOIL APPLICATIONS

FIRST CHOICE Boron Liquid 10% should be applied with enough water or liquid fertilizer to ensure placement availability. Irrigation, tillage, or rainfall may be used to get the Boron into the plant's root zone.

FOLIAR APPLICATIONS

FIRST CHOICE Boron Liquid 10% should be applied with enough water or liquid fertilizer to completely cover all foliage. Late evening or early morning applications will yield the best results.

APPLICATION RATES

FOLIAR APPLICATIONS

Apply 1 to 5 quarts of **FIRST CHOICE Boron Liquid 10%** per acre mixed with water or liquid fertilizer.

SOIL APPLICATIONS

Apply from 1 quart up to 2 gallons of **FIRST CHOICE Boron Liquid 10%** per acre mixed with water or liquid fertilizer depending upon application methodology.
